

Information and consent request pursuant to and for the purposes of art. 13 of the 2016/679 EU Regulation on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data

Dear Sir/Madam _____

We inform you, pursuant to art. 13 of the EU Regulation, that the personal data provided by you to the undersigned company are subject to the treatment provided by the same law. We remember that processing means any operation or set of operations, performed with or without the aid of electronic or automated systems, concerning the collection, registration, consultation, organization, preservation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, dissemination, deletion and destruction of the personal data of the data subject.

The purposes of this processing, which will take place using automated and non-automated methods, are those related to the evaluation of an application for a possible working relationship or collaboration with the writer.

The provision of such data is optional, the refusal to provide certain data could lead to an incorrect evaluation of his professional qualities.

The data in question will not be disseminated and will be processed by our company for a period of 12 months, after which the data will be destroyed.

In addition to the Data Controller, the persons in charge of the processing involved in the selection operations may be informed of your data.

We assure you that all communications will take place in accordance with the law and, in particular, will be strictly connected to the purposes set out above. The data will not be disclosed or communicated outside the EU.

When evaluating the above in order to give us your consent to the treatment, please note that among the personal information object of the same and provided spontaneously there may also be some data defined as "particular" (ex Article 9 c.1 of the Regulations) (relating, in particular, to belonging to protected categories)

It should also be noted that the data we are or may be in possession of and supplied by you may also be inherent to your family members, so that your consent will automatically affect the latter.

You can contact the Privacy Service at the data controller to verify your data and have them supplement, update or rectify and / or to exercise the other rights provided for in Articles. 15 of the Regulations (shown below) and 16, 17, 18, 20. You can contact the Guarantor for the protection of your rights.

Art. 15. Regulation UE 2016/679

1. The data subject has the right to obtain from the data controller confirmation that the processing of personal data concerning him or her is in progress and, in this case, to obtain access to personal data and the following information:
 - a) the purposes of the processing;
 - b) the categories of personal data in question;
 - c) the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be communicated, in particular if recipients of third countries or international organizations;
 - d) where possible, the retention period of the personal data provided or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine this period;
 - e) the existence of the right of the interested party to request the data controller to rectify or delete personal data or limit the processing of personal data concerning him or to oppose their treatment;
 - f) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
 - g) if the data are not collected from the data subject, all information available on their origin;
 - h) the existence of an automated decision-making process, including the profiling referred to in Article 22 (1) and (4) and, at least in such cases, significant information on the logic used, as well as the importance and expected consequences of such processing for the interested party.
2. Where personal data are transferred to a third country or to an international organization, the data subject shall have the right to be informed of the existence of adequate safeguards pursuant to Article 46 relating to the transfer.
3. The data controller provides a copy of the personal data being processed. In the event of further copies requested by the data subject, the data controller may charge a reasonable fee contribution based on administrative costs. If the interested party submits the request by electronic means, and unless otherwise indicated by the interested party, the information is provided in a commonly used electronic format.
4. The right to obtain a copy referred to in paragraph 3 shall not affect the rights and freedoms of others.
